93% of Littles reported maintaining or improving their ability to **regulate their emotions**.

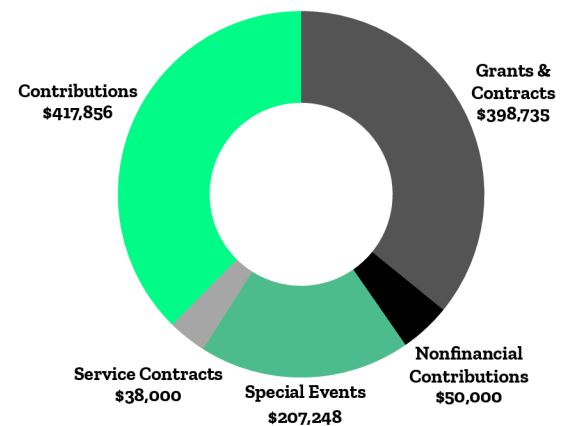
67% of Littles who had engaged in bullying behaviors in the past demonstrated a decrease in their engagement of these same behaviors.

60% of Littles were **not engaged in school discipline** measures, such as parental meetings, detention and/or suspension.

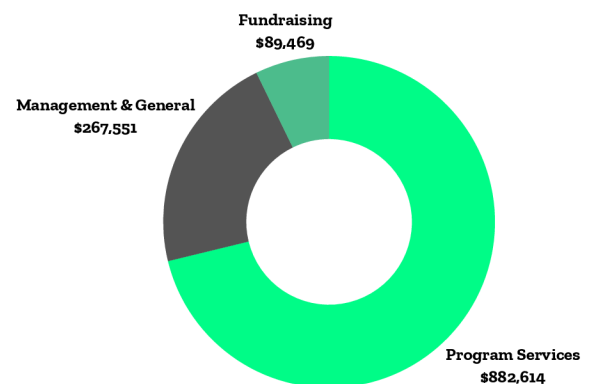
93% of Littles did not engage of the use of drugs or alcohol.
